Carrier is confident in their cooling products and expertise that they offer a variety of comprehensive extended warranty programs to further protect your investment.

In addition to the standard 5-year factory parts and labor limited warranty, you can now extend the parts and labor coverage and/or parts-only coverage for years of custom-made indoor comfort. That means, depending on the program you choose, if you have any problem with your system, Carrier will provide a replacement part and/or the labor at no cost to you. Extended warranties offer many additional advantages, including:

- Assurance that any necessary repair work will be performed by an expert Carrier service technician.
- Original parts will be replaced only with genuine Carrier parts.
- Unexpected repair bills will be kept to a minimum.
- Improved home value through warranty transferability (as long as the equipment remains in its original configuration at its original installation site).

With several different options to choose from, you may obtain a Carrier customize warranty program.

Parts & Labor

- 2nd through 10th Year Labor with 6th through 10th year Parts

Labor Only

- 2nd through 5th Year Labor
- 2nd through 5th Year Compressor Labor
- 2nd through 10th Year Compressor Labor

Parts Only

- 6th through 10th Year Parts Only
- 6th through 10th Year Compressor Parts Only
- 20 Year Heat Exchanger Parts Only

Remember that routine maintenance—such as cleaning and/or changing the air filters and keeping indoor and outdoor coils clean—will help ensure peak performance of your system during the warranty period and beyond.

What does my warranty cover?

Under the standard factory warranty, Carrier covers the parts, and your installer covers the labor. A warranty certificate was included with your homeowner information packet, and is specific to the model numbers, serial numbers and installation dates of your products. If you cannot find your warranty certificate, your Carrier Dealer will also be able to provide you with the information.
